Appointment of Deborah C. Poff, PhD

Dr. Deborah Poff has been appointed as the Executive Vice President and Provost at Pacific Coast University for Workplace Health Sciences (PCU-WHS). Since August 1, 2015, Dr. Poff held the position of Vice President Strategic Development at the University.

Dr. Poff has served in a number of administrative positions during the course of her career. She was previously the President and Vice Chancellor of Brandon University.
