Policy Statement

The University is a registered not-for-profit charity and welcomes donations of any sort to the University from the community. It is the policy of the University to ensure a strong base of ongoing financial support to the University by soliciting donations from a wide range of sources. Ownership of all gifts vests in the University, whether they are for the benefit of the University generally or for some specific purpose in it.

Definitions

University means Pacific Coast University for Workplace Health Science, a corporation established under the Act.

Procedures

The University may elect to accept or decline a gift.

The Board of Governors reserve the right to make the ultimate decision regarding the disposition of donations.

The University will provide a charitable income tax receipt to all identified donors.

The University respects a donor's right to anonymity and will ensure access to records is restricted wherever the law permits.

All gifts-in-kind shall be appraised for purposes of establishing value.

Fundraising efforts shall be conducted according to accepted professional standards of accuracy, truth, integrity and good faith.
