## Institutional Evaluation – Policy 245

### *Definitions*

University means Pacific Coast University for Workplace Health Science, a corporation established under the Act.

University Community means members of the Board of Governors, members of the Academic Council, members of the International Research Advisory Council, students, employees, contractors and volunteers associated with the Pacific Coast University for Workplace Health Sciences.

### *Regulations*

At least once in each seven-year period, there will be an institutional review, separate from program reviews. This review will include:

- a self-study by faculty and administrators relating to the performance of the organization and each of its programs,
- an assessment of this self-study by a panel of external experts appointed by the Board of Governors,
- an institutional response to the comments and recommendations of this report, and
- a summary of the conclusions of the process made available to the University Community.
