

Residency - Policy 095

Policy Statement

In order to earn a University certificate, diploma or degree a student must normally complete at least forty percent (40%) of the credits necessary for the graduation award with Pacific Coast University for Workplace Health Sciences.

Related Policy Approval of Graduands

Definitions

Residency means that a student who earns a graduation award has studied with Faculty Members and other students with the University.

University means Pacific Coast University for Workplace Health Sciences, a corporation established under the Act.

Procedures

The Registrar will implement procedures to ensure that students have met the Residency requirement.

Credits earned through Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition do not normally meet this requirement.
