The online CDMP Examination Preparation Workshop

Achieving the Certified Disability Management Professional (CDMP) designation requires a solid understanding of disability management principles, legislation, return-to-work practices, and ethical decision-making. Success also depends on the ability to apply this knowledge in complex, real-world scenarios. The CDMP certification examination assesses not only foundational knowledge, but also the application of competencies and critical thinking expected of effective disability management professionals.

This examination preparation workshop provides a structured, competency-based review of the core domains assessed on the CDMP examination. Drawing directly from the CDMP Examination Blueprint and Occupational Standards, the course focuses on how key concepts are tested, how exam questions are constructed, and how candidates can approach both independent and case-based multiple-choice questions with confidence. Emphasis is placed on applied reasoning, legislative interpretation, and practical decision-making, consistent with professional disability management practice.

This workshop does not replace formal education or professional training. Instead, it supports candidates in applying their existing knowledge effectively within an examination context. Participants are expected to bring a solid, working understanding of disability management principles, legislation, and practice, acquired through formal education and professional experience. The focus of the workshop is on examination readiness, developing the skills required to analyze scenarios, interpret questions, and select responses that reflect competent professional judgment under examination conditions.

Designed for disability management practitioners, return-to-work coordinators, human resources professionals, and others with relevant experience, this course strengthens readiness for the CDMP certification examination.

Learning Outcomes

By the end of this workshop, participants will be able to:

- Describe the structure, format, and weighting of the CDMP certification examination.
- Identify the core competency domains and essential skills assessed.
- Apply disability management knowledge to exam-based scenarios.
- Interpret legislation, benefit programs, and ethical standards in examination decision-making.
- Use effective strategies to analyze and respond to independent and case-based multiple-choice questions.
- Recognize common exam question patterns and distractors, and select the most appropriate response.
- Demonstrate professional judgment and critical thinking consistent with the expectations of the Certified Disability Management Professional designation.

The purpose of this workshop does not lend itself to formal assessments. While there will be exam-style questions each day, they are intended for self-assessment only. There are no CEC hours associated with this workshop. Completion of this workshop will not be accepted as part of formalized education under eligibility criteria.

Please note that this workshop does not teach DM material. Rather, it is designed to help participants apply their gained knowledge to answer questions. It is assumed that participants already have the necessary knowledge gained through formal DM/RTW education programs, have completed the required relevant work experience, and who meet the examination eligibility requirements.
